Hourglass is the only charity in the UK dedicated to ending the abuse of older people.

- It's estimated 2.7 million people across the UK are affected by abuse, yet it's rarely reported in the media or discussed in Parliament.
- Over 12,000 people reach out to Hourglass' helpline services, seeking advice, support and information related to the abuse of an older person
- Our helpline team are contacted from those affected by abuse and by those worried about the safety or wellbeing of an older relative or friend
- Hourglass does more than just pledge to help those calling the helpline. We deliver IDVA (Independent Domestic Violence Advocate) and case work support, as well as events in local communities.
- Hourglass helps those affected by physical abuse, sexual abuse, neglect, financial abuse, psychological abuse and domestic abuse

Feedback from one of our callers

We were contacted by a family member who was concerned about a elderly relative she felt was being financially abused. Our helpline team advised her to talk with a legal professional experienced in this area who was able to help.

This is what she said:

"I contacted you in desperation as my lovely aunt, who had been diagnosed with Alzheimer's, was being financially abused. At the time of contacting you, I had been constantly hitting brick walls, as I had no legal rights as my Aunt's niece. You was my last hope.
